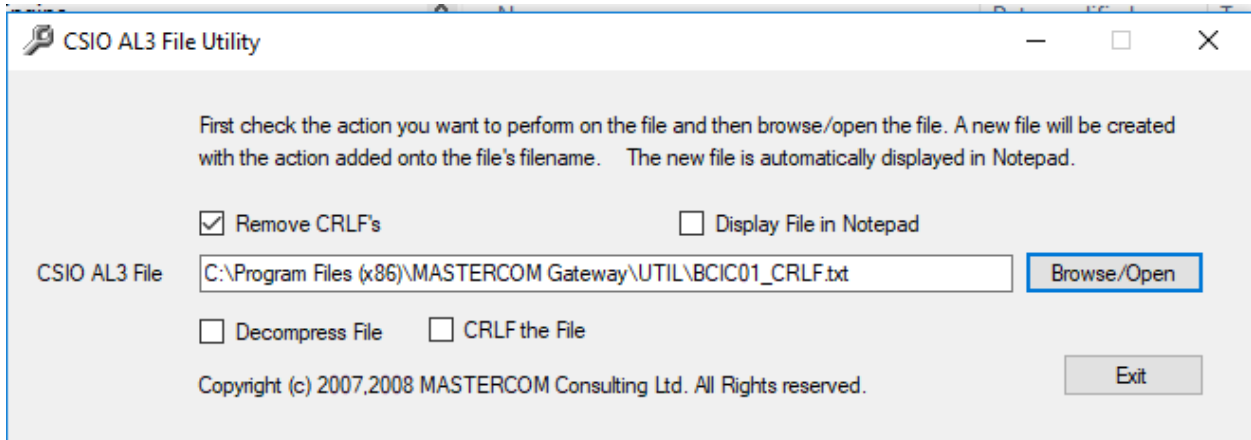

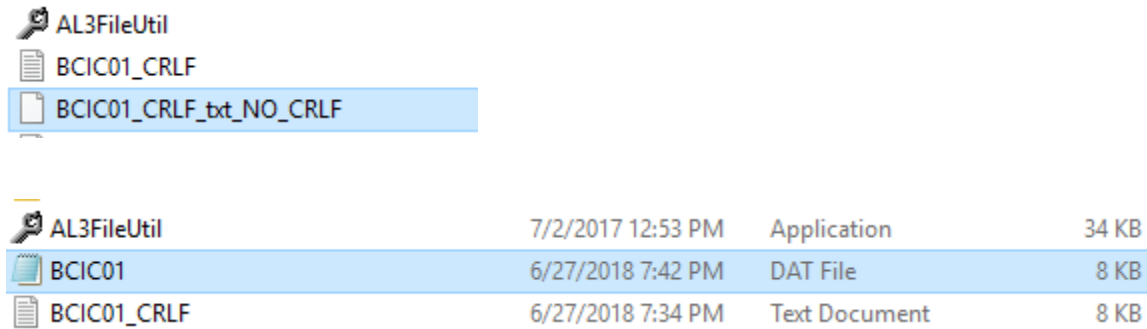

- 4) Using the MASTERCOM “AL3FileUtil.exe” utility, as shown below, check the “Remove CRLF’s” checkbox and click the “Browse/Open” button and select the BCIC01_CRLF.txt file.



It will create a “BCIC01_CRLF.txt_NO_CFLF” file, as shown below.

- 5) Now rename the “BCIC01_CRLF.txt_NO_CFLF” file to BCIC01.dat as shown below.



- 6) Move the “BCIC01.dat” file to \EMAIL folder and do a “Reformat Latest CSIO Download” and a “Merge Daily Download”.
