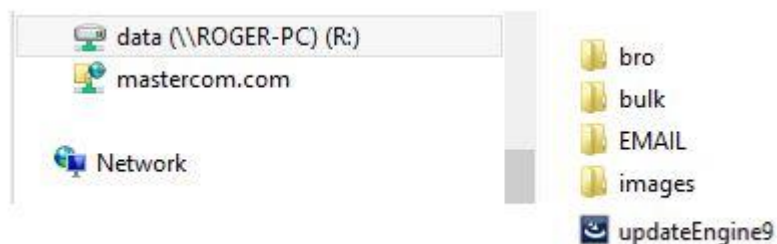


## Steps to Update from Version 9 to a newer Version

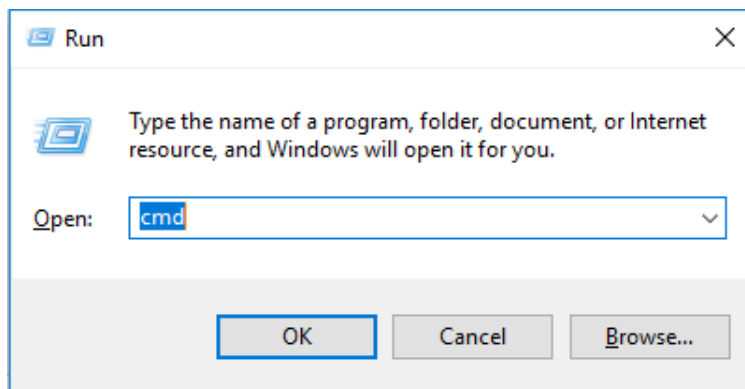
Steps to update the BrokerEDIPC E-Mail-EDI Engine on your server to a newer Version of 9. Normally newer versions will be named with a minor number e.g. 9.2 and with alpha if the update is a patch e.g. 9.2b

- 1) Go to the user's PC that runs the daily download communications.
- 2) After having downloaded and saved the newer Version in your **\Downloads** folder, move e.g. updateEngine9.exe from the **\Downloads** folder to the **mapped drive** where the folders **\EMAIL** and **\BRO** reside, as illustrated below.

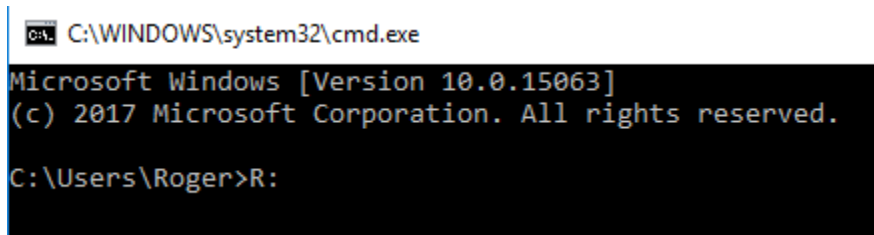
**In this case the mapped drive is R.**



Go to the command prompt by holding the Windows Key down and type "R" and in the "Run" dialog box, as shown below, type "cmd" and click the **OK** button.



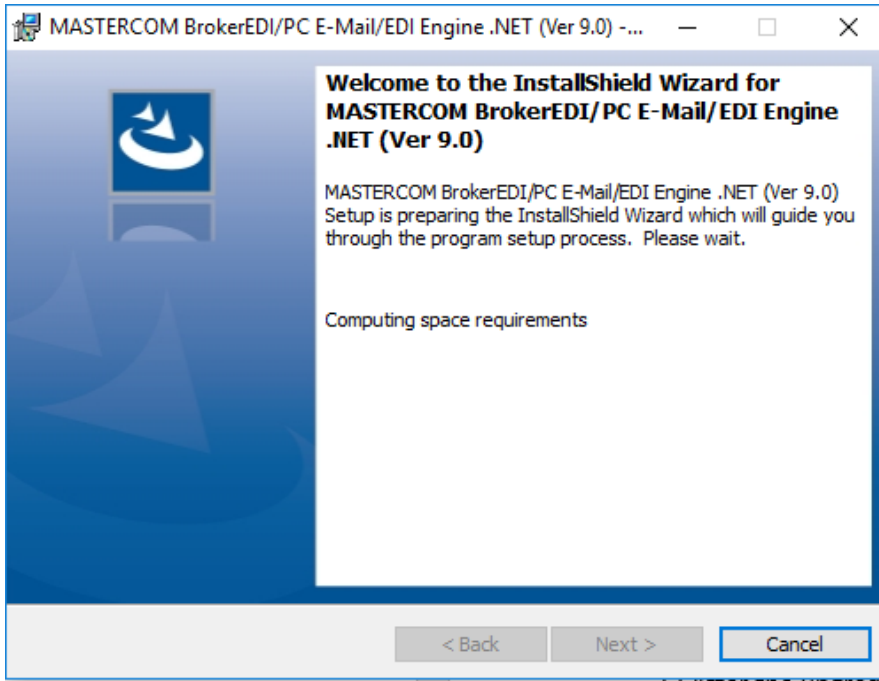
- 3) At the command prompt, type your mapped drive letter, colon and press the <Enter> key e.g. **R:<Enter>**, as shown below, to switch to the R: drive.



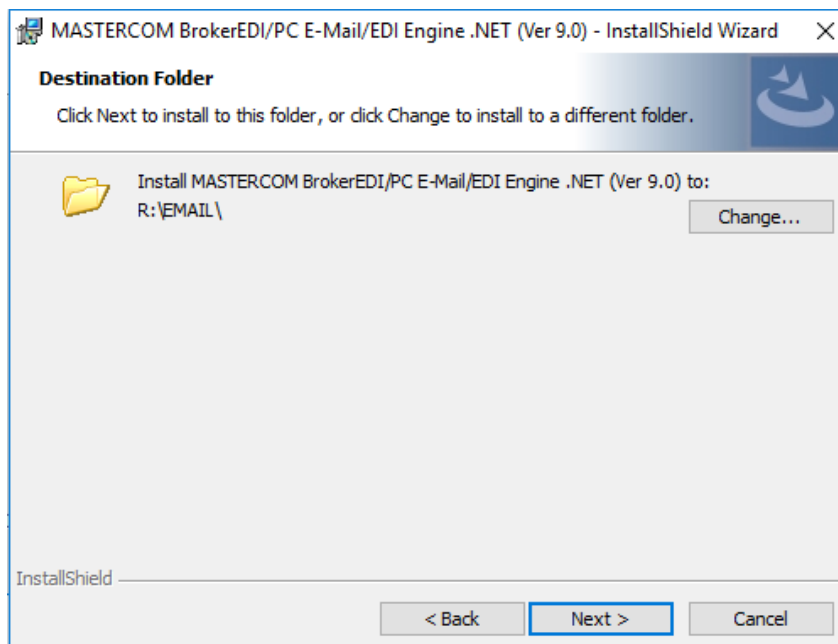
## Steps to Update from Version 9 to a newer Version

4) At the command prompt, as shown below, type e.g. **updateEngine9x.exe<Enter>**

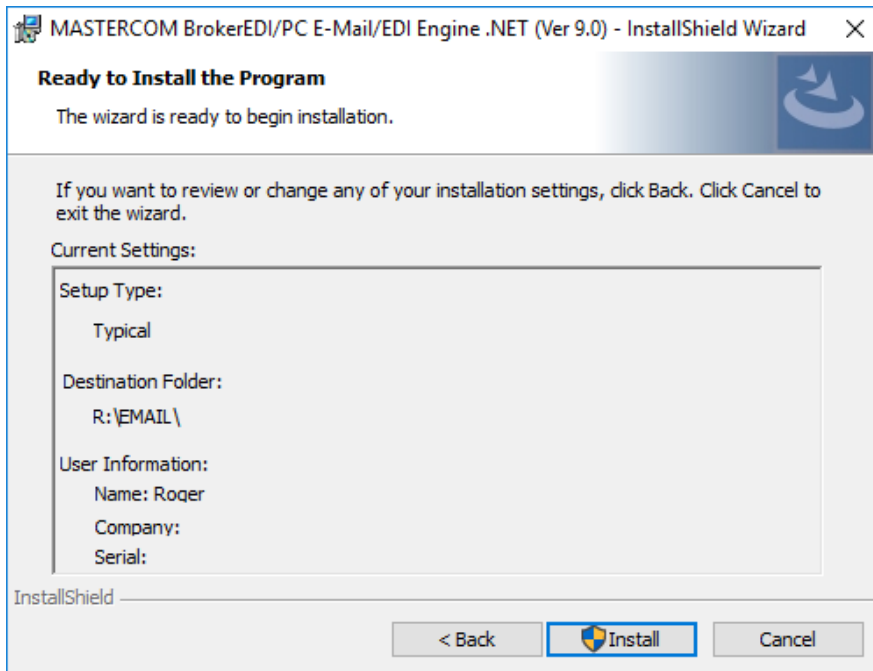
R: **\updateEngine9x.exe<Enter>** to initiate the “InstallShield” installation “Wizard”.



Keep clicking “**Next**” to continue until you get to the “**Destination Folder**” display where you would again click the “**Next**” button, as shown below. Note: the “**Destination Folder**” would be in this case, as shown above, “**R:\EMAIL\**”

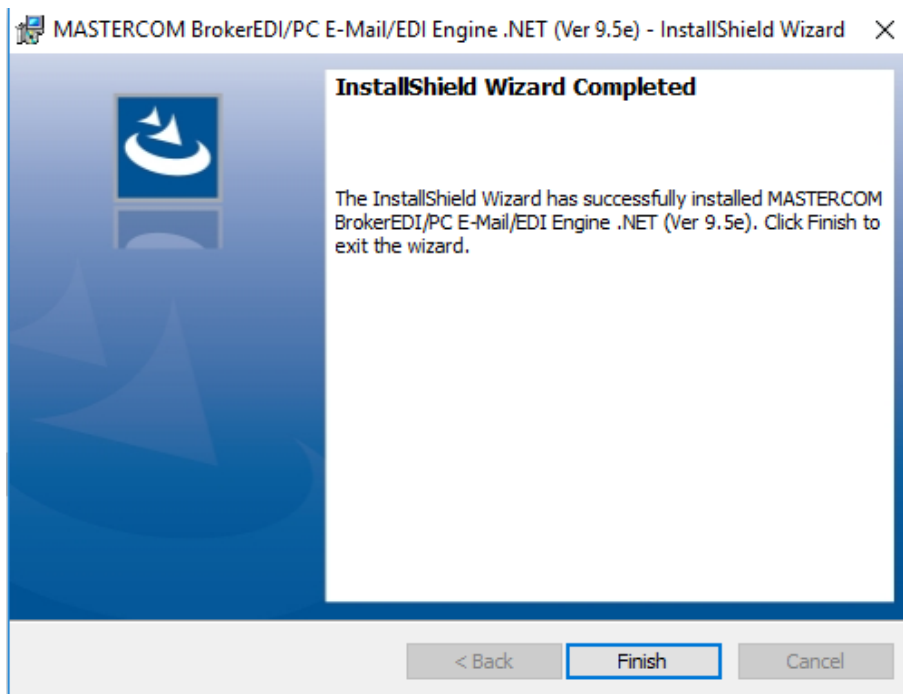


## Steps to Update from Version 9 to a newer Version



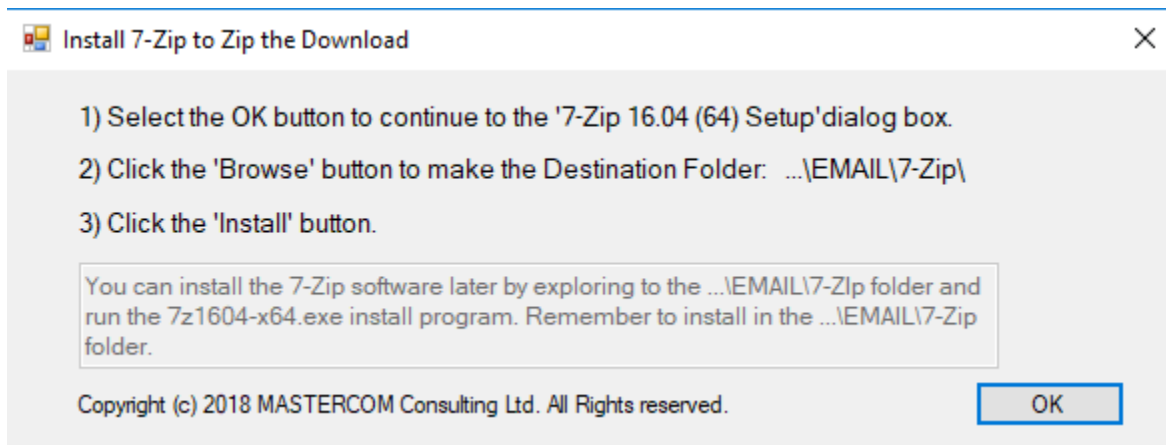
Click **“Install”** to continue.

When you get the **“InstallShield Wizard Completed”** display, as shown below, click the **“Finish”** button to complete the update of the BrokerED/PC E-Mail/EDI Engine.

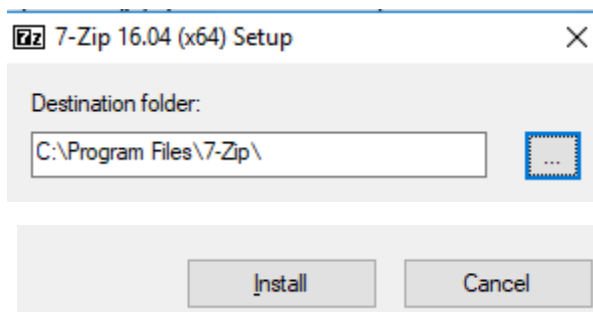


## Steps to Update from Version 9 to a newer Version

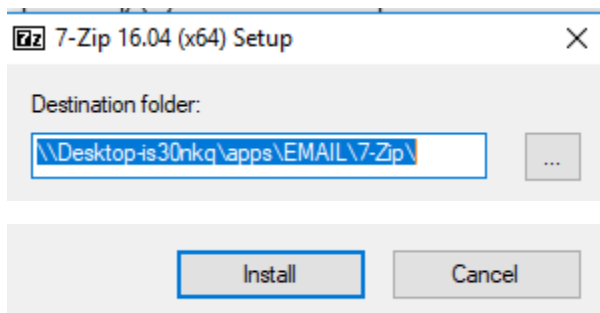
5) After the “Finish” button is clicked you may get the following dialog box, if the 7-Zip zipping software needs to be installed.



The “7-Zip 16.04 (x64) Setup” defaults to installing in the “C:\Program Files\7-Zip” folder.



Click the Browse button or type in the UNC path, as illustrated below to the ...\\EMAIL\\7-Zip folder.



After the 7-Zip software is installed you will get the prompt to restart the computer,
